For you that might take a lot of faith to believe because you are struggling right now with something you've been praying about for a long time. Jesus' promise boldly hangs right out there. I don't have to apologize for it. But I will have to wrestle with it. Jesus certainly wrestled in his prayers! I will too. So I will keep on praying because I know he loves me.
